Site Assessment:

Leesville Road Branch in Jackson is the newest OceanFirst Bank Branch in Ocean County. Existing landscaping includes a perimeter garden on three sides of the building, constituting 7 different beds, each receiving varying degrees of sun and shade. A soil test revealed the 7.05 soil pH is slightly higher than optimum range for the growth of most perennials, however, the soil pH is buffered by the high level of existing organic matter. Macronutrients are at optimum levels; micronutrients are adequate. The sandy soil has satisfactory levels of electrical conductivity needed for plant nutrient intake.



Testing the soil is an important step in planning a garden.
